

Quick Start Guide

For MPEG-H Audio Content Creation Tool Trademark Program

The Content Creation Tool Trademark Program (CC-TMP) is a free-of-charge program by Fraunhofer IIS which ensures that the MPEG-H Production Software is correctly implemented. It is a self-certification process in which MPEG-H Master files are checked for the correct metadata. Tools that have been validated according to the CC-TMP procedures are eligible to be referred to as "MPEG-H certified" and may display the MPEG-H Audio logo. Fraunhofer IIS strongly encourages participation in this program to ensure interoperability and content integrity.

Your tool delivers MPEG-H Audio?

- Contact Fraunhofer IIS and ask for the CC-TMP. Fraunhofer IIS will send a contract for your signature.
- You sign the contract and send it back to Fraunhofer IIS.

The CC-TMP test suite

- Fraunhofer sends the test suite including test audio files as well as a tutorial that explains what to do with the files and how to validate the resulting material.

Self certification

- According to the supported MPEG-H Audio features of your product, test scenarios are selected.
- Analyze or author MPEG-H metadata with your tools.
- Analyze the results.
- Enter the results in the pdf form provided by Fraunhofer IIS. The pdf form is set up to display your certification result at the end of the process.
- The entire test should not take longer than a few hours.

You can use the MPEG-H logo!

- After performing the self certification, send the results and files to Fraunhofer IIS.
- You are allowed to use the MPEG-H Audio logo to indicate that your product meets MPEG-H Audio interoperability requirements.
